Fenne Lily Releases New Standalone Single, [“To Be A Woman Pt. 2”](#)

23-year-old Bristol musician **Fenne Lily** releases a new standalone single, “**To Be A Woman Pt. 2**,” her second song for **Dead Oceans**. Following the breezy “**Hypochondriac**,” “To Be A Woman Pt. 2” bounds with restlessness, an urge to start anew. Over a pacing drum beat and angsty, driving arpeggios, she maps the sound of knowing you’re in the wrong company. Throughout, Fenne inverts her more-often straightforward confessional style. Now the heartbreak is a background to her own internal monologue, advising against the pitfalls of her past.

“Usually when writing about rage, most of the initial anger I feel towards the person or situation becomes diluted through the recording process, but this song was different. ‘To Be a Woman Pt. 2’ is a call to arms,” says Fenne. *“It’s raw and furious, coming from a place of frustration and pain born from a loss of control and a breach of trust. The result of a manipulative relationship, it’s both a retaliation against subordination and a reclamation of power.”*

While “To Be A Woman Pt. 2” and “Hypochondriac” are introductions for most, Fenne’s self-released debut album, 2018’s **On Hold**, has stuck with many, quietly going viral, [garnering play-after-play on streaming services](#). Fenne first took North American stages when she opened for **Lucy Dacus** and **Andy Shauf**. This August, Fenne makes her stateside return supporting **Waxahatchee** across the midwest. Then, she will tour across the United Kingdom and Europe.
