Bremer/McCoy Release New Single/Video, [“Gratitude”](#)

New Album, *Natten*, Out 10/29 on Luaka Bop

Bremer/McCoy, the duo of pianist **Morten McCoy** and bassist **Jonathan Bremer**, release a new single/video, **“Gratitude,”** from their forthcoming new album, ***Natten***, out **October 29th on Luaka Bop**. Bremer/McCoy recorded *Natten* straight to tape. *“When it works for me,”* says pianist **Morten McCoy**, *“it’s pure meditation, pure prayer. Pure gratitude for simply being, without all kinds of jibber-jabber filling my thoughts.”* This is the ethos radiating throughout today’s single.

“I wrote the main melody for the chorus of ‘Gratitude’ one late evening after a session in the studio,” says McCoy. *“I was just sitting and vibing, playing, reflecting on the day and then suddenly this melody just came to me out of nowhere, actually together with the baseline. And it came together with some simple words. I was singing in my head ‘og jeg takker,’ which is basically ‘and I give thanks for that.’ That moment of time, that was just everything, the feeling of being in the universe, where there’s this loving energy, just very present, and the feeling of being humble and grateful for being able to sustain myself by doing what I love, and the feeling*

of being grateful to have such a nice family, friends around me. I was just very grateful and humbled by simply being in that moment of time.”

The accompanying video, directed by **legendary Super 8 director Paul Diddy**, reflects this openness, with video clips of vast, open land and water.

Bremer/McCoy insist on traveling with their own sound system. That might seem like a lot of effort for a quiet Danish duo, but for Bremer/McCoy, making music is all about what happens in the room. It’s also why they record analog. When they write music, they aim for direct transmission—idea straight to composition. *Natten* is the follow-up to a string of albums - their debut ***Enhed*** (2013), ***Ordet*** (2015), ***Forsvinder*** (2016), and ***Utopia*** (2019). “*We felt a greater freedom this time around because we now have a much deeper understanding and grounding in what we’re doing,*” says Bremer. “*This allows us to venture further out than ever before, because we know that things typically fall into place.*”

Natten, which means “The Night” in Danish, draws inspiration from the end of day, that regenerative time under the constellations when our lives look different. Listeners might be quick to call it escapist—the music might be a reprieve from our busy lives. And while that’s one way to experience *Natten*, there’s also another, which has more to do with immersion. It offers us the chance to see what’s around us as beautiful.

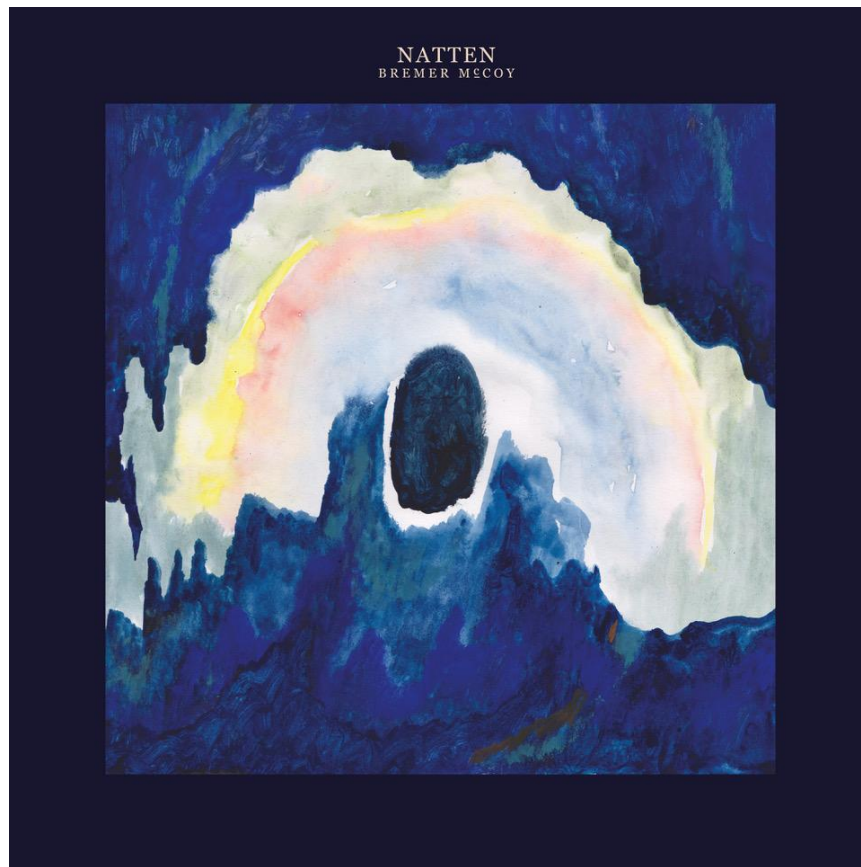
