Last night, **The Weather Station** played *Jimmy Kimmel Live!*, marking their **late night television debut**. This appearance precedes the release of *How Is It That I Should Look At The Stars*, the companion album to 2021's critically acclaimed *Ignorance* out **March 4th on Fat Possum**. For *Kimmel*, **Tamara Lindeman**, alongside **Ben Whitely** (bass), **Evan Cartwright** (drums), **Johnny Spence** (keys), and **Will Kidman** (guitar), gave a dazzling performance of "Tried to Tell You," a standout off of *Ignorance* through which Lindeman "[conjures] an image of environmental negligence as arresting and lyrical as Joni Mitchell's paved paradise" (*The New York Times*).
