Mitski is “both a disciplined lyricist and technician who balances tension, tenderness, aggression, and the odd splash of macabre humor with consideration; every note feels intelligent on a Mitski record” (*ELLE*). This absolutely rings true across ***Laurel Hell***, her new album released earlier this year on **Dead Oceans**. Today, she presents a **Clark remix** of one of its singles, “**Love Me More**.” Already a disco-tinged and urgent number, this rework by Clark ups the ante. Its oscillating percussion and distressing synth bolster Mitski’s vocals into a pleading cry: “*I want you to love me more.*”

“Clark’s music, specifically his album *Death Peak*, was what opened my eyes to contemporary electronic music,” says Mitski. “It showed me how emotive it could be. So when I was asked to do a remix, he was the first and only person that came to mind for the job.”

Clark adds: “Huge pleasure to be asked to do this, thank you. I love what Mitski does. I spent ages on the kick. Haven’t done that for a while, but it all comes flooding back.”
